Licinius I (308-324 AD) / Follis 317-320 AD / Bronze / 19 mm / 2.8g

Valerius Licinianus Licinius:

Roman emperor from 308 to 324. For most of his reign he was a colleague and rival of Constantine I, with whom he drafted the Edict of Milan (313 AD), which officially granted tolerance to Christians in the Roman Empire.

Constantine I:

Latin: Flavius Valerius Constantinus; 27 February c. 272 - 22 May 337, also known as Constantine the Great, was Roman emperor from 306 to 337 AD, and the first to convert to Christianity. Born in Naissus, Dacia Mediterranea (now Niš, Serbia), he was the son of Flavius Constantius, a Roman army officer of Illyrian origin who had been one of the four rulers of the Tetrarchy. Constantine served with distinction under the Roman emperors Diocletian and Galerius. He began his career campaigning in the eastern provinces before being recalled to the west (in 305 AD) to fight on the side of his father in Britain. After his father's death in 306, Constantine became emperor. He was acclaimed by his army at Eboracum (York), and emerged victorious from the civil wars against the emperors Maxentius and Licinius to become sole ruler of the Roman Empire in 324.

Constantine II (337-340 AD) / Bronze / 19 mm / 2.8g

AV.: FL IVL CONSTANTINVS NOB C, head of Constantine II, laureate, left.

RV.: PROVIDEN-TIAE CAES, camp gate with two turrets, without doors, with 7 stone layers; star above. SMNA in exergue.

Constantine II:

The eldest son of Constantine the Great and Fausta, was elevated to the rank of Caesar as early as 317. In 328, under the supervision of his father and officials, he took charge of the western part of the empire (Gaul), where he resided in Augusta Treverorum, now Trier. There he successfully defended the borders against the Goths and the Alamanni. After the death of his father in 337, several members of his family were murdered, but the reasons for this purge are not clear. He finally had himself proclaimed Augustus together with his brothers Constantius II and Constans. After a meeting of the brothers in Viminatium, they divided the empire between them.

04 Roman Antoninianus: IMP GALLIENVS AVG / ROMAE AETERNA (Q)

Gallienus (253-268 AD) / Bronze / 23 mm / 4.5g

AV.: IMP GALLIENVS AVG, head of Gallienus, radiate and cuirassed, right. RV.: ROMAE AETERNA, emperor standing to right, receiving Victory from Roma seated to left, holding spear; pellet in wreath above. Q in exergue.

Galienus:

Publius Licinius Egnatius Gallien was Roman emperor with his father Valerian from 253 to 260 and alone from 260 to 268. He ruled during the crisis of the third century that nearly caused the collapse of the empire. He won a number of military victories against usurpers and Germanic tribes, but could not prevent the secession of important provinces.

Maxentius (307-312 A.D) / Bronze / 24 mm / 6.3g

RV.: CONSERV VRBS SVAE, Roma seated, facing head left, in temple, holding globe and sceptre, shield at side. RBS in exergue.

Maxentius :

Emperor of the West Roman Empire. Maxentius was the son of the Emperor Maximian. Angered at not being elevated to emperor in 305, he settled outside Rome, and when Galerius decided to extend taxation throughout Italy, he saw an opportunity to lead an uprising. He also joined Constantine I and called on his father Maximianus to resign. Severus tried to retake Rome, but his troops fled to Maximianus and he was killed. Galerius himself attacked Rome, but he too failed to put down Maxentius' rebellion.

Maximian tried to seize power from his son in 310, but failed and fled to the protection of Constantinople. After a conference organised by Diocletian, Galerius and Maximian, the tetrarchy was restored, leaving Maxentius in control of Italy and Africa. However, his popularity began to decline and he faced rebellions. In 312, Constantine finally marched on Rome and Maxentius' troops were killed in the battle at the Milvius Bridge as they were retreating towards Rome. Maxentius himself was sayd to be killed as he tried to swim to safety.

Michigan-Painter:

The Michigan Painter was an Attic black-figure vase painter who worked in Athens in the last guarter of the 6th century BC. He was named by John D. Beazley after a neck amphora in the Kelsey Museum of Archaeology at the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor. The painter, who belonged to the Perizoma group, painted mainly Stamnoi and small neck amphorae of the dot-band class; the neck amphorae of the group originally compiled by Beazley as the Brussels R 312 group are also by him. In addition, he painted oinochoes and lekyths. He also painted the backs of Panathenaic prize amphorae, the fronts of which were decorated by the Havana Owl painter.

Ancient Attic Lekythos in Six's Technique, Attributed To The Meidias Painter

Athens / 420 - 400 B.C. / Ceramic / H = 14 cm (5 33/64 in)

Extreme rare attic squat lekythos, painted in Six's technique. Attributed to the Meidias Painter.

Meidias Painter :

The Meidias painter is a Greek vase painter of the Attic red-figure style. He worked in Athens in the last quarter of the 5th century BC. Beazley called him the Meidias Painter naming him after the signature of the potter, Meidias (q.v.), whose vase in the British Museum he decorated.

The Meidian style has variously been called florid or mannerist and may owe something to the rich style of Attic sculpture from the 5th century BC. His compositions are " polygnotan " in that they have no single baseline but are arranged in frieze steps across the belly of the vase. The favourite forms of Meidia's Painter and his followers were hydriai among the larger forms and squat lekythoi, choes and a variety of pyxids and lecanids preferred for smaller pieces. Meidian figures can be recognised by their long profiles, large eyes, small mouths, rounded chins and the frequency of the three-quarter portrait. His women are slender and long-legged, his men tend to be voluptuous and both enjoy tapering fingers and toes. He pays particular attention to the details of clothing, iewellerv and hair: All his women wear earrings, necklaces, hair ornaments and bracelets, their hair is in individual curls and elaborate hairstyles, and their dress is usually made of sheer, multiply pleated peplos that billow out in bloom. John Beazley attributed 22 vases and fragments to the Meidias painter with a further 2 possible attributions. A definite attribution is

complicated by the large number of followers that the Meidias painter's elaborate style has produced.
